# VADODARA - SAYAJI NAGRI

Vadodara or Baroda, situated on the banks of the river Vishwamitri was earlier the capital city of the Gaekwad state. Archaeological remains dating back to two thousand years around the river Vishwamitri clarify that there was a small settlement known as the Ankottaka, near a grove of Akola trees, which is now called Akota. Then a kilometer down east, a locality came up near a thick forest of vad or Banyan trees. This area was called Vadapadraka. In the place of Vadapadraka, today's Vadodara has come up. The word Vadodara is derived from the word 'Vatodar'. This Sanskrit word means 'the stomach of the banyan tree'. Later during British rule this name degenerated into Baroda and was known so until recently till it returned to the original name.

Baroda has a rich historical background. The ardent historian can trace Baroda's history over 2000 years and more. However, the recent threads can be picked up when the Moghul rule over the city came to an end in 1732, when Pilaji brought the Maratha activities in Southern Gujarat to a head and captured it. Except for a short break, Baroda continued to be in the hands of the Gaekwads from 1734 to 1949.

Maharaja Sayajirao was one of the foremost administrators and reformers of his times. He initiated a series of bold socio-economic reforms. He attached great importance to economic development and started a number of model industries to encourage initiative, and then handed back the working industries to private enterprise. He started model textile and tile factories. It is as a result of his policy of industrial development that Baroda is today one of the most important centres for textile, chemical and oil industries today. He boldly introduced compulsory primary education and a library movement (the first of its kind in India) to augment his adult education scheme.

The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda (MSU), formerly Baroda College is a public university in the city of Vadodara, in Gujarat state, India. Originally established as a college in 1881, it became a university in 1949 after the independence of the country. It was later renamed after its benefactor Maharaja Sayajirao Gaekwad III, the former ruler of Baroda State.

The university offers undergraduate, post-graduate, and doctoral programs. It houses 89 departments spread over 6 campuses (2 rural and 4 urban) covering 275 acres of land. The university has its origins in the Baroda College, established in 1881 by Baroda State. The main building, which houses the Faculty of Arts, was designed by Robert Fellowes Chisholm in Indo-Saracenic architecture style, in a fusion of Indian and Byzantine arches and domes in brick and polychromed stone. The main dome on the convocation hall was modelled after the great dome of the Gol Gumbaz in Bijapur.

Pratap Singh Gaekwad of Baroda (1908–1968) (the last Maharaja of the erstwhile Baroda State) founded the university in 1949 on the wishes of his grandfather, Maharaja Sayajirao Gaekwad III (1863–1939), and settled the "Sir Sayajirao Diamond Jubilee and Memorial Trust" which exists to date, catering to the education and other needs of the people of the former Baroda State.

The old Baroda College founded in 1881 consisted of Arts and Science sections. The Faculty of Science started its independent existence in March 1951 with Dr C.S. Patel as its first dean. The Old Building which houses the Faculty of Science at present was completed in about 1934 in the reign of Sayajirao Gaekwad III. It is conspicuous by its small copper dome and is flanked on the west by the building of Faculty of Education and Psychology and on the east by the majestic building of the Old Baroda College, now the Faculty of Arts.

As a premier centre for Physics learning in India, the department, established in 1949, offers U.G., P.G. and PhD programme and is a sponsored department of Department Of Science and Technology, Government of India under FIST programme. In M.Sc., students are offered Solid State Physics, Electronics and Communication, Nuclear Physics, and Molecular Spectroscopy as specialization. The department is also equipped by two of the oldest and famous observatories: (i) Astronomical Observatory and (ii) Meteorological observatory.

Researchers are provided with advanced technologies including FTIR-4100 Spectrometer, Thermal Analyser (DSC), AFM, Workstations-4, Cluster Computing facility (Supercomputer), etc. which help them in researching on Condensed Matter Physics, Material Science, Experimental Nuclear Physics, Spectroscopy, Theoretical Particle Physics and Astrophysics.[3]

It is one of the oldest Physics departments in India, which adopted advanced curricula based on Courses viz, Berkeley Physics Course, Feynman Lecture Series, etc. under the leadership of S.K. Shah and H.S. Desai. Department has an active society, notably 'The Physical Society MSU Baroda'.[4] Department of Condensed Matter Physics has been sponsored for researches in coordination with TIFR and BARC by DST-FIST as a major beneficiary. Department is indulged in a number of active researches with record endowments. The university holds the accolade of having worldwide spread Departmental alumni, including Nobel Laureate cum President, Royal Society, Venkatraman Ramakrishnan.

The Department of Biochemistry was established in 1955, under the Chemistry Department, and was headed by Prof. C.V. Ramakrishnan, father of 2009 Chemistry Nobel Laureate Venkatraman Ramakrishnan). The department has a Center for Nutritional Studies. The department was awarded an Excellent status in 2006 by FIST, a Government of India accreditation agency. It imparts master's degree courses in Biochemistry & Medical Biotechnology with a force of around 50 research students.

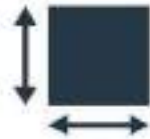
The Biochemistry Department offers courses in enzymology, genetics, molecular biology, neuroscience, plant biochemistry, endocrinology, clinical biochemistry among others. The department conducts research in areas including bacterial cooperation, polyketide synthase clusture, antibiotic resistance, Apoptosis, phosphate solubilisation, nitrogen fixation, probiotics, heavy metal toxicity, diabetes, prostate cancer, female infertility, endophytes, magnetoliposomes, protein folding, and vitiligo.

The department was funded under the DST-FIST I programme under which new equipment has been purchased and infrastructure facilities strengthened. The department has received support from UGC-DRS, UGC-DSA and COSIST programs.

The department has a strong base in Microbial technology and the main focus of the program is on Genetics, Molecular Biology, Industrial Microbiology, Immunology and other areas allied to Microbiology and Biotechnology. Basic training is

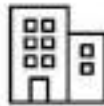

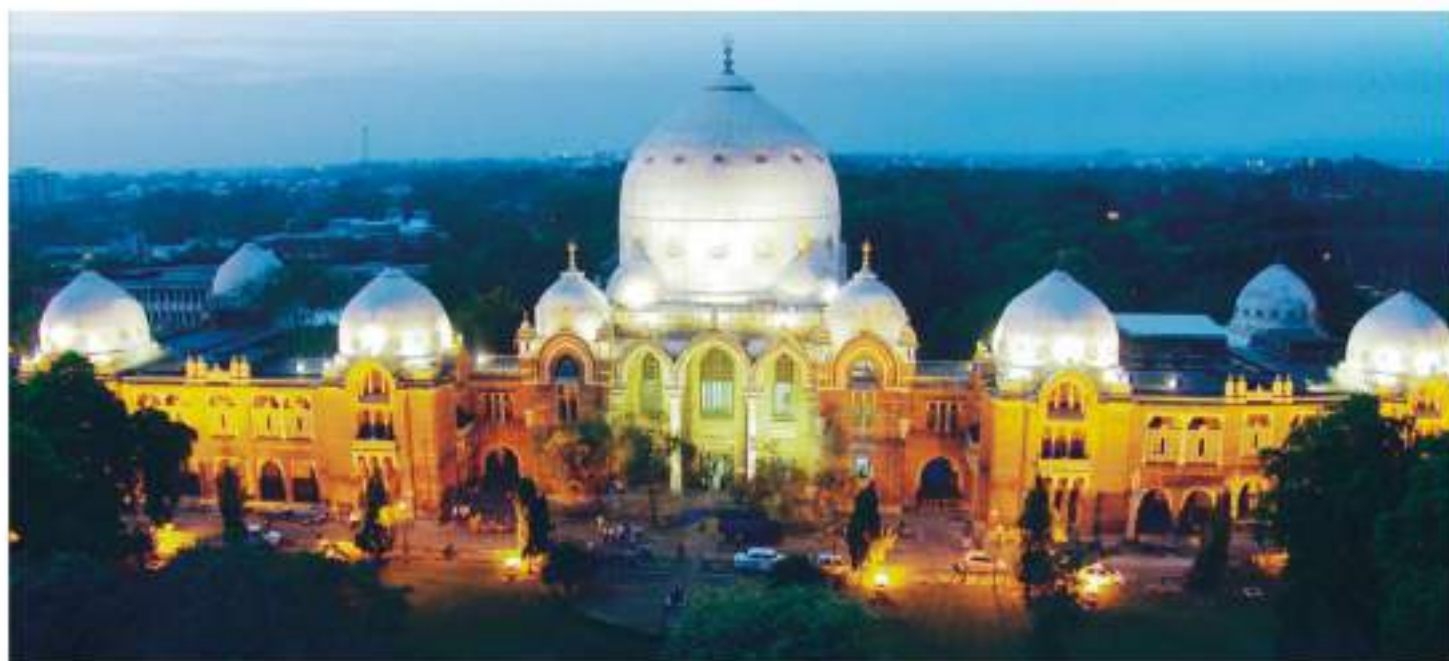

# Faculty of Arts



A premier institution of teaching and research in languages, social sciences and the humanities, the Faculty of Arts, owes its genesis to The Baroda College, established in 1881 by H. H. Maharaja Sayajirao Gaekwad – III of the erstwhile Baroda State. The Faculty is sanctified by the name of the seer and philosopher, Sri Aurobindo Ghosh, who had been appointed by Sir Sayajirao to teach English and also as the Vice-Principal of the erstwhile Baroda College.

The idea of establishing a Separate University for Baroda was mooted first as early as 1927 by Sir Sayajirao himself. It came into existence on April 30, 1949, at the time of the merger of the Baroda State with the State of Bombay. Necessary changes were incorporated into the constitution of the Baroda College with a view to establishing separate Faculties in the University. Thus, the Baroda College, one of the oldest Centres of learning in Western India, came to be known as The Faculty of Arts.

The alumni of the erstwhile Baroda College and the present Faculty of Arts included well-known personalities like Acharya Vinoba Bhave, Shri Ranga Avdhuta, Shri Mota, Shri K. M. Munshi, Kakasaheb Kalelkar, Shri Rajendra Shah, Dr. M. N. Srinivas, Dr. B. Subbarao, Dr. I. G. Patel, Dr. V. Y. Kantak, Dr. Suresh Joshi, Dr. Sitanshu Yashashchandra and others.

The founding vision of the Faculty was charted, realized, and furthered by eminent academicians and stalwarts in different disciplines, and it remains committed, through its sustained efforts, to the enhancement of this rich tradition as well as the expectations and demands of the present day changing environment. Among other institutions in the region, the position of the Faculty of Arts is distinguished by the wide variety of disciplines in which it imparts training and knowledge.

The Faculty has always endeavoured to establish a network of intellectuals with a view to contributing to the cause of knowledge and imparting education, responsive to the changes taking place in the field of knowledge and technology, to encourage multi and interdisciplinary research, to introduce and develop courses, bringing them in line with contemporary theoretical developments and also relate them to societal concerns and issues. It also attempts at promoting and developing educational opportunities in tandem with the demands of social justice.

In an endeavour to bring all its Programmes in line with the proposed uniform pattern all over the state and the country, with effect from the Academic Year (2011-2012), the Faculty of Arts introduced a Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), initiated by the National Knowledge Commission, University Grants Commission and the Association of Indian Universities.

# Faculty of Education & Psychology



The Faculty of Education & Psychology of the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda has its origin from the Secondary Training College, Baroda. Mr. R. Littlehaile's, Education Commissioner with the Government of India, made a survey of Education in the Baroda State in 1933. He found the paucity of Trained Teachers in Secondary Schools of the state. In his report he recommended starting of a Secondary Gaekwad accepted the proposal and established Secondary Teachers Training College, Baroda in 1935. It was affiliated to the University of Bombay in the year 1938. This institution became the Faculty of Education & Psychology in the year 1949 as the constituent of the Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda with two departments - Education and Psychology. The Practicing High School of the Secondary Teachers' Training College was also reorganized into the University Experimental School with all the Primary and Secondary classes for Practice Teaching and Experiments. In the year 1951, the Department of Educational Administration was set up. It was followed by the establishment of two more Departments, viz., The Department of Extension Services in 1955 and the Department of General Education in 1957 which offered General Education courses to the students of different faculties of the University. The Faculty today consists of three departments, viz., the Department of Education, the Department of Educational Administration and the Department of Psychology; the University Experimental School. The Faculty also houses the University Employment Bureau in its CASE building

# Faculty of Medicine



The College started its working from June, 1949. This is a Government Institution affiliated to the M.S. University of Baroda. The College is housed in a spacious modern Three Storeyed Building 300 ft in length and breadth. The Department of Anatomy, Physiology are placed on the Second Floor. The Ground Floor consists of the Department of Preventive and Social Medicine, Administrative Block, Medicine Department, Clinical Chemistry and Bio-Chemistry Department etc. In addition to the spacious laboratories for each department, well equipped museum for the Anatomy, Pathology and Preventive and Social Medicine Departments, are also housed in the college building. Also exists in the college building a separate Animal House, Cold Storage for dead bodies, Post-Mortum Rooms and Outpatient Department and Research Centre are in the associated block near the main college building. Attached Shree Sayaji General Hospital, where clinical instructions are imparted, has six Medical, six Surgical, four Obst. and Gynaecology, two Paediatrics, one Dental, two E.N.T., three Orthopaedic, one Anaesthesia Unit and one Psychiatry Unit, one Skin V.D., one Plastic Surgery, two C.T. Surgery, and two Ophthalmology, one Neurology and one Urology Clinic are also started at this College. The students are posted under these units for their clinical training.

In 1884, Shrimant Sayajirao Gaekwad III founded a "Sangeet Shala" in Baroda. This became the college of Indian Music, Dance and Dramatics, part of the Faculty of Fine Arts, at the inception of the M.S. University in Baroda in 1949. Since 1986, it has been known as the Faculty of Performing Arts, one of the star institutions in India for in-depth study of the classical performing arts.

The erstwhile Baroda State had done pioneering work in many directions. The educational plan of the state included the study of fine arts and music as far back as 110 years ago. Sayajirao Gaekwad III was all for art education and to him goes the credit for creating the first school of music in India. For the first in this country, the University of Baroda put the seal of recognition on the teaching of fine arts at the University level.

It is a unique faculty of its kind in the entire western region, which imparts training at the university level in performing arts viz. Music, Dance and Drama offering courses up to Ph. D. in these disciplines. Over & above the Indian Students from different regions, it also attracts students from various foreign countries viz; U.K., U.S.A., Bangladesh, Nepal, Mauritius and Japan.

The goal is to train students to develop their creative and intuitive abilities whereby attaining a systemic understanding of the art and science of performing arts and its aesthetic applications.

# Faculty of Technology & Engineering



The Faculty of Technology and Engineering as it stands today formed alongwith the establishment of the Maharaja Sayajirao University in 1949 is an outgrowth of what was popularly known as the "Kala Bhavan Technical Institute" (KBTI) established in June 1890 by his late Highness The Maharaja Sayajirao Gaekwad III of Baroda state. In May 1990, it completed 100 years of glorious services for the cause of Technical Education.

The Kala Bhavan started its activity in 1890 with the modest but novel objective of producing skilled artisans and apprentices by imparting instruction in local language in the following fields:

Civil, Mechanical, and Electrical Engineering, Drawing and Printing, Architecture and Photo engraving, Textile Chemistry including Dyeing, Bleaching, Sizing & Printing, oil and Soap making etc, With the assistance of German experts and foreign trained teacher under the able stewardship of Principal T. K. Gajjar. Other courses on Textile Technology (weaving), Furniture making and Fine Arts were started later. Principal C. H. Vora consolidated these pioneering efforts into a Polytechnic by starting a variety of Diploma and Certificate courses in the above major disciplines, with the additional staff, laboratories and buildings. The Polytechnic status with steady development continued until 1949 when the Kalabhavan was converted into the Faculty of Technology and Engineering (with the establishment of The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, following generous donation by the Gaekwads for the University and the New Building of the Institute). From this stage onwards, the Institute developed rapidly recognizing no bounds.

These hectic developments resulting in creation of 15 departments (Department of Pharmacy was under Faculty of Technology and Engineering till 2015), a workshop, a library and several buildings were possible due to the financial support mainly from UGC and aided by UNDP, USAID and Government agencies and also due to the dedicated efforts by the Institute, Deans and Teachers. Faculty laboratories and departments received massive aid of \$1,050,000 for development from the United Nations Development Program (UNDP). The aid was given to develop infrastructure

# Polytechnic



The concept of having an institute for providing Technical Education was first conceived in August 1886 during a prize distribution ceremony at Baroda College. In order to fulfill the dream of maintaining the pace of Baroda College with the increasing requirements of technical know how in various fields of Engineering & Technology, His Late Highness Maharaja Sayajirao Gaekwad III of Baroda State established Kalabhavan, a Technical Institute in 1890 at Kalabhavan Baroda. The prime objectives of the institute at that time were to improve the existing industries, and to introduce a few more industries in the State of Baroda, which will be participating in the industrial development of the country.

The Kalabhavan was primarily started as an Arts and Crafts School offering education in various arts and crafts like;

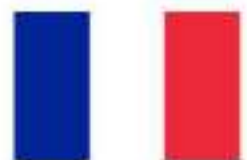
